

Greater Little Zion Baptist Church Scholarship Committee Bylaws
Revised May2025

Requirements to Obtain the GLZBC Undergraduate Scholarship

1. Applicant must currently be an active member of the Greater Little Zion Baptist Church (GLZBC) and an auxiliary of the church for at least a six-month period prior to the issuance of the scholarship.
2. Applicant must have at least a 2.25 Grade Point Average (GPA).
3. High school applicant must submit a completed application, letter of college acceptance, high school transcript, letter signed by the head of a GLZBC auxiliary in which applicant is a member, and two letters of reference. Current college student applying for the first time must submit a letter signed by the head of a GLZBC auxiliary in which the applicant is a member and a college transcript with at least twelve **(12)** semester hours of **earned** credit for each semester in an accredited college or university, or full-time in a vocational/trade school.
4. **All items cited above must be received by the stated deadline.**
5. Applicant must be admitted as a full-time undergraduate student, or enrolled full-time in a vocational/technical program.

Requirements to Retain the GLZBC Undergraduate Scholarship

1. Student must submit a copy of grades immediately following each semester. The GPA after the fall and spring semesters will be considered for retention of the scholarship. The GPA after the spring semester augmented by the GPA after the summer session may be considered for a scholarship for the fall semester. The GPA after the fall semester augmented by the GPA after the winter session may be considered for a scholarship for the spring semester.
2. Recipient must maintain a 2.25 GPA on the 4-point scale or a 1.75 GPA on the 3-point scale to retain the scholarship.
3. Recipient must reapply for the scholarship each academic year and be an active member of the Greater Little Zion Baptist Church through worship and fellowship.
4. Recipient must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student with at least twelve **(12)** semester hours of **earned** credit for each semester in an accredited college or university, or full-time in a vocational/trade school. The earned credits after the spring semester augmented by the earned credits after the summer session may be considered for a scholarship for the fall semester. The earned credits after the fall semester augmented by the earned credits after the winter session may be considered for a scholarship for the spring semester.

Stipulations for Use of the GLZBC Undergraduate Scholarship

1. Scholarship aid will be used for tuition and books only.
2. Student is to receive scholarship for no more than four (4) years unless approved by the Committee.

3. The Committee reserves the right to approve or deny any request for a scholarship.

The amount of the scholarship award will be determined each year based on the number of scholarship applicants and available funds.
